MAIN IDEA

Spend some time praying in quiet solitude. Don't just lift up prayer requests to the Lord, but listen for his promptings. If it would help spend some time praying through some of the scriptures provided: Psalm 145, Romans 12 and Colossians 3:1-17.

CLOSING PRAYER 15 min

Close your time praying for our community. Pray through the prayer prompts provided or anything else the Lord lays on your heart. Our God wants us to not only show our community love but to love our community like he does!
